Phase I Construction Plan Review Comments

Sir/Madame:

The Planning Department has completed its review of the above referenced plans received January 2, 2015 and has the following comments:

- 1. Provide the approval letter from the Planning Commission meeting.
- 2. Revise the GPIN numbers on the cover sheet, only 784-767-4440 and 784-766-7690 should be used.
- 3. Revised #6 on the cover sheet; it should read B-3 and B-3C.
- 4. Revised #10 on the cover sheet. For simplicity remove "restaurants" and only use the total square footage of the buildings.
- 5. Provide another category and provide site data for the entire shopping center; i.e. PH I and PH II.
- 6. Remove POD 37-11 from all sheets.
- 7. Clarify #15 on the cover sheet "The ground area covered by <u>all the buildings</u> shall not exceed in the aggregate 25% of the total area. Use square footage in lieu of acreage and provide data for the entire shopping center.
- 8. Can the waterline easement be shifted to be completely within the asphalt on sheet 25?
- 9. Provide the detail of the fence to adequately address proffer 13d.
- 10. Label the 50 foot buffer adjacent to Stone Wall Glen.
- 11. Provide entrance wall details.
- 12. Provide details of the retaining wall near the intersection of Route 1 and Jeb Stuart Pkwy.
- 13. If you know where outdoor dining will be located, provide that information on the construction plans.
- 14. Staff request that sidewalks directly adjacent to the buildings be decorative, and/or have tree wells.
- 15. Provide a joint ingress/egress maintenance agreement between the Marriott and this POD.

The Planning Department has not yet received comments from all other agencies. Upon receipt of all review comments, I will notify you of the appropriate action for resubmission of plans.
