Sir/Madame:

The Planning Department has completed its review of the above-referenced Concept Plan, received June 27, 2022, and has the following comments:

- The proposed development requires approval of a Plan of Development (POD). Provide 13 sets of construction plans, four (4) sets of architectural plans (including floor plans), a completed application signed by all property owners and requisite fee. Technical submission requirements may be found on the attached POD application.
- 2. On all architectural elevations, include building materials, color descriptions, and dimensioned heights.
- 3. Proffers of C-30C-89 apply. Proffer No. 8 requires high-quality building materials and architectural consistency between all buildings.
- 4. The following lot dimensional requirements apply:
 - a. Lot area 1 acre
 - b. Lot width 100' feet
 - c. Maximum height 110' feet (unless additional height granted per Sec. 24-2306)
 - d. Front 40' feet
 - e. Side 20' feet
 - f. Rear 40' feet
- 5. Trade schools are subject to the use specific standards of Sec. 24-4309.C.
- 6. Should 300 or more parking spaces remain on-site, parking must meet the standards of Sec. 24-5107, Design Requirements for Large Parking Lots.
- 7. Include overall and individual amounts of required parking spaces for the existing and proposed buildings. Trade schools require 2.5 parking spaces per each 1,000 S.F.
- 8. Provide internal pedestrian connections.
- 9. Provide a conceptual landscape plan which includes the following:
 - a. A transitional buffer 50 is required adjacent to the RTHC and R-6C Districts.
 - b. Minimum tree canopy coverage of fifteen percent (15%) is required.
 - c. Interior parking lot greenspace equaling at least five percent (5%) of the total area used by vehicles, including parking spaces and drive aisles.
 - d. Parking lot landscaping per Sec. 24-5312.

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- 10. Provide a lighting plan with modeled footcandles, pole and mounting details, and manufacturer specifications. All exterior light fixtures must be full cut-off fixture types.
- 11. See additional comments from other review agencies.
